Board Meeting – July 11, 2019

Minutes

Meeting:

President Queguiner called the meeting to order. The minutes of the June Board and Treasurer Report were approved on a motion by Sue LeBlanc Durocher with a second provided by Roger Black.

Membership/Attendance Report — Roger Black reported that the committee met last week and the membership documents are being updated on the website. The move from red to blue badge section will be updated. Attorney Andrew Brockway has expressed an interest in rejoining Sunrise Rotary. He was a member several years ago and resigned his membership to go to law school. There was some concern from Board Members about Mr. Brockway's arrest earlier this year. - •Signage Jack Helfgott, Noon Rotary's Immediate Past President, is having his sign designer create a vinyl sticker with Rotary's website that can be put on the signage. We do need better signage at Perkins both at the entrance and also near the elevators. Jeff and Sue may have sandwich board type signs that we can use.
