Board Meeting – September 8, 2022

Minutes

Present: Jeff Prescott; Jessica Kline; Michelle Senecal; Roger Black; Eric McDowell; Tom Defayette; Jim Snook

Meeting - President McDowell called the meeting to order and asked if there were any corrections to the August meeting minutes. There being to changes, the meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Tom Defayette and seconded by Roger Black. All voted in favor.

Treasurer's Report – Jessica Kline reported that we still haven't received an invoice from the City of Plattsburgh for Mayor's Cup parking. Dues are being paid; currently 53% of members have paid. August financials show two donations and the money for Mayor's Cup T-shirts was paid by Thom Loreman. We were negative \$3.69 in MHAB meeting room revenue and meeting charges. Each meeting costs \$164.97. Roger reported that the check to pay for the tulips was missing. Should we stop payment and issue a new check? Roger will follow up with Rotary International. On a motion by Roger Black and seconded by Michelle Senecal, the Treasure's Report was approved. All voted in favor.

Handicap Wheelchairs – A meeting was held this past Friday at the City Beach with Courtney Meisenheimer from the Mayor's Office. In order to get the wheelchairs to work properly, a ramp will need to be installed and beach mats purchased. Funds donated to this project by The Foundation of CVPH can be used to help fund these items. Project will be launched the summer of 2023. It was also mentioned that there are accessibility issues accessing the gazebo and bathrooms that should be dealt with by the city.

Environmental Committee – Roger Black recently attended a Rotary conference where the environment was the topic. Roger thinks the environment might be a good topic to attract younger members. Roger will work with Noon Rotary's Environmental Committee to develop a newsletter and identify local and worldwide environmental projects we might be able to help with. Will also look at partnering with Saranac Lake and Ausable Valley rotaries.

Treasurer Role – With Michele Kali's relocation, we are looking for a third person to add to the treasurer's role. Jessica is serving this year and Eric next year when his presidency is over. Looking for a person to fill this role in the 2024-2025 year. Nadine and Ann will be asked to see if either one is interested. Like the presidency, the treasurer role will be a yearly rotating role.
