Board Meeting – May 12, 2022

<u>Minutes</u>

Present: Jeff Prescott; Jessica Kline; Michelle Senecal; Roger Black; Eric McDowell; Kathy Snow; Colleen Downs; Sue LeBlanc Durocher; Tom Defayette

Meeting - President Prescott called the meeting to order and asked if there were any corrections to the April 2022 meeting minutes. Roger asked that the minutes be corrected under the End Polio Tulip Fundraiser section to say that the fundraiser "netted Polio Plus \$825." There being no other changes, the April minutes were approved on a motion by Eric McDowell and seconded by Roger Black. All voted in favor.

Treasurer's Report – Jessica reported that the financials continue to look good. One member still owes half of their dues. We are currently not losing money on the weekly meetings at MHAB. On a motion by Eric McDowell and seconded by Roger Black, the Treasurer's Report was approved.

Weekly Meeting Format – The committee met and agreed to remove one meeting per month. The week will be the week of the Board Meeting. Members have the option of attending the Board Meeting. During the off week, committees can scheduled their meetings. This change in meeting format will be trialed for three months (June-August). The attendance requirement will be removed but Roger will continue to take attendance. There was also discussion of excused vs. absent. These changes will be discussed at an upcoming club assembly meeting. By-Laws will be changed to reflect these changes.

Mayor's Cup Update – Sue updated the Board on recent Mayor's Cup activity. We are awaiting the Mayor's Cup press conference date from the City of Plattsburgh. Sponsorships are coming in.

Attendance – Alaina's attendance is a concern. Kathy Snow will follow up with Alaina.

Beach Wheelchair Project – Colleen shared that the wheelchairs will be ordered with the hope that they arrive before Mayor's Cup. We are a little short on our fundraising dollars. Sunrise has \$600 budgeted for conference attendance. This \$600 will be moved to the wheelchairs. Tom Defayette mentioned that the ARC may have more money to give to this project.

Meeting - President Prescott called the meeting to order. The May meeting minutes were unavailable and will be in the July meeting packet

Treasurer's Report – On a motion by Sue LeBlanc Durocher and seconded by Eric McDowell, the treasurer's report was approved. Colleen mentioned that we have funds at Community Bank and Glens Falls National Bank. Should we look at investing? The finance committee will look into this.

End Polio Now Tulip Fundraiser – Income from this fundraiser is on the balance sheet.

RYLA –Tom Defayette reported that Jacob Mitchell from Peru Central School completed RYLA training. He will come to one of our upcoming meetings to talk about it. Going forward we should provide a travel stipend to students attending RYLA training. Tom also shared that Rotary has a connection to scouting and that he is the district representative. On June 18 there will be a ceremony with four scouts becoming Eagle Scouts. Tom will be asking Rotary for \$450 to send a scout to summer camp.

Gazebo Project – Work is finishing up on the gazebo. Jessica will arrange a photo op with the CV Tech students working on the project.

New Meeting Format – Eric has updated the calendar in Club Runner to reflect the new meeting format.

Rotary Dinner – Our end of year dinner is scheduled for Wednesday, June 22 at Vesco Vineyard. Past Sunrise members will be invited to attend. CV Tech students and RYLA attendee will also be invited to attend the dinner. On a motion by Sue LeBlanc Durocher and seconded by Colleen Downs, it was agreed that Rotary would pay for the guests to attend.

Mayor's Cup – Sue reported that we are currently at \$14,000 in sponsorship which is \$5,000 more than expected. Money needs to be put aside to market Mayor's Cup. Board agreed that \$500 could be set aside for this.

4th **of July Parade** – The theme of this year's parade is "Music in America". Our float will have a sailboat theme. The t-shirt design students from CV Tech would like to walk behind our float in the parade.
